Status Update Assessment Plan for the Academic & Administrative Support Unit submitted by Ellen Okuma, 3-9-12

- Attachment A, HawCC Policies & Procedures Manual, as of August 15, 2011 was developed to determine the baseline number and titles of the policies in the Manual.
- Outcome #3 was chosen for the first iteration to assess.
- #3 of the Assessment Plan, 4th bullet was revised to include additional recipients of the report of results—Assessment Coordinator and co-chairs of U-WAG.
- Assessment of outcome #3 will be done after the Spring 2012 semester ends.
- A Report of results will be written and sent to the recipients identified in #3 of the Assessment Plan.

Academic & Administrative Support Unit Assessment Plan Results June 6, 2012

- 1. Outcome 3 was chosen for the first iteration of the unit assessment plan for Academic & administrative Support. Outcome 3 is: 20% of HawCC policies are new or have been revised by the end of each academic year.
- 2. On August 15, 2011, there were 51 policies (see Attachment A, pages 6-8). To meet the 20% target, 10 policies would need to be either new or revised.
- 3. Three policies were revised, reviewed by the Academic Senate, approved and posted to the online manual during the Academic Year of 2011/2012. Those policies are: *HAW 5.304: Repeating Courses* (revised, 2-14-12); *HAW 9.204: Student Evaluation of Instructors and Lecturers* (revised, 2-14-12); and *HAW 9.205: Peer Evaluation of Instructors and Lecturers* (revised, 2-14-12).
- 4. One new policy was developed and approved: *HAW 4.201: Integrated Planning for Institutional Effectiveness* (issued, 11-28-11).
- 5. In addition, several new policies were developed and have been either sent to the VCAA for forwarding to the Academic Senate Chair for review and approval or have been sent by the VCAA to the Academic Senate Chair for review and approval:
 - o *New and Modified Courses* was on the Academic Senate's agenda for May 3, 2012 but was tabled until more time can be spent on reviewing it during Fall 2012.
 - o *Credit Hour* was developed for HawCC but was deferred until the new UHCC policy is issued. HawCC's draft was used to develop the UHCC policy.
 - o *General Education* was developed for HawCC but was deferred until the new UHCC policy is issued.
 - o *Faculty Absence* was developed for HawCC and was sent to the VCAA on April 10, 2012.
 - o *Lecturer Absence* was developed for HawCC and was sent to the VCAA on April 10, 2012.
 - O Developmental Education was developed for HawCC as a result of recommendations from the Developmental Education Enrollment Policy (DEEP) Task Force. It was sent to the VCAA who then sent it to the Fall 2011 Senate Chair. Further follow-up during Spring 2012 indicated that the policy is being reviewed by the Educational Policy Committee.
 - o *Course Outline of Record* was developed for HawCC and was sent to the VCAA on March 12, 2012.
 - o *Assigned Time/Overload* was developed for HawCC and was sent by the VCAA to the Human Resources Director for review during Fall 2011.
- 6. The DEEP Task Force also recommended that *HAW 5.501: Placement Testing* be revised. The revision was done with 2 options. Follow-up during Spring 2012 indicated that the policy is being reviewed by the Educational Policy Committee of the Academic Senate.

- 7. One policy has been reviewed and revised. It does not require Academic Senate approval. *HAW* 1.001: Policies and Procedures Manual was sent to the VCAA on April 9, 2012 for the Administrative Team to review and approve.
- 8. Non substantive edits were made to *HAW 7.505: Class Attendance*, *Disappearer and No Show Policies*. The changes were made and the policy was reposted during December, 2011.
- 9. A total of 15 policies were either developed and submitted for review by appropriate offices or individuals or were reviewed for revision. This number is 29% of the existing policies (51) that were in effect in August, 2011. Twenty-nine percent exceeds the 20% target for reviewing policies during the 2011/2012 academic year.
